just a part of the orchid depending on how it inspires you and how you want to image to look.

How long have you been a photographer?

I have always loved taking pictures throughout my entire life. Three years ago I bought a digital single-lens reflex camera (used by dedicated amateur and professional photographers). I started to really learn about photography principles and techniques by attending photography classes and photography seminars, and by joining area photography clubs.

What do you do for a living?

I work at Lake Health's West Medical Center as a medical technologist in the microbiology lab.

How many years have you been attending Orchid Mania, and what keeps you coming back?

I have been to the Cleveland Botanical Gardens on a few occasions; however, this was my first time attending Orchid Mania. I loved the variety and colors of orchids on display. I will definitely be back next year!

What is the secret to taking good photographs of flowers?

Pay attention to the background. If you want the flower itself to be the center of attention, compose the photo so there are no distracting elements in the background. Normally a blurred background works best. You can also use a cloth or poster board to create a "fake" background. Always make sure the flower (or part of the flower you want to emphasize) is in focus.
